Three Strategies

Ubiquity

For the achievement of ideal ITS implementation, any transport related objects including anything from people to things should have proper Transport Intelligence anywhere, anytime and for anything.

If these "3 Any" conditions are guaranteed, it shall be sufficient for a ubiquitous level of availability.

Transparency

To increase user-friendliness, the objects in the transportation system can be provided with ubiquitous transportation services without any consciousness or recognition based on the individual location & context. The transport subjects including drivers, passengers, pedestrians, and consignors can get real-time traffic information from the ubiquitous transportation environment that is calm, pervasive, and invisible.

Trustability

Ubquitous transportation society aims to provide reliable traffic information and service which can be achieved by the collective information among locally networked smart objects.

Ultimately, all ITS services under ubiquitous society should be trustable in terms of its timely properness, accurateness, and usefulness.




Exhibition - Layout




